I. WHAT IS THE ACCUPLACER? WHY SHOULD I PREPARE BEFORE TAKING IT?

The Accuplacer is a placement test used to help determine which Writing classes you are ready for at Kodiak College, UAA. This adaptive computer-based test has two sections: Writing and Reading.

While preparation is **not** required, we do advise it because the higher you score, the fewer classes you'll have to take to reach your goals!

II. BEFORE THE TEST

- Make an appointment with a tutor in The Learning Center to:
 - ✓ *Create a realistic study plan* for yourself.
 - ✓ *Complete practice questions* using the "Accuplacer: Sample Questions for Students" handout and/or the official Accuplacer Study App.
 - ✓ Learn some test taking strategies.

Schedule your testing appointment at least 48 hours in advance.
